

Placement Policy for PhD Students
Career Development Cell, IIT Goa

Before proceeding with various Career Development Cell (CDC) formalities, all PhD students should take note of the following points:

1. The CDC serves as a facilitator and counselor and cannot guarantee job placement.
2. Placement opportunities are considered a privilege rather than a right.
3. Registration for placements is not compulsory, and students who are not interested in placements are advised against registering.

Eligibility and Registration:

1. PhD placements operate independently from the regular placement cycle for B.Tech and M.Tech students. PhD students can participate in campus placements only after approval of the synopsis and receiving an approval letter from their faculty advisors. They can register at any time during the year. To register, they need to submit a form and upload the approval letter signed by their thesis advisor.
2. PhD students are eligible to apply for all companies (open to PhD students) visiting the campus for placements. It is also recommended that students provide a list of relevant companies they wish to be considered for. The CDC will try to approach these companies for necessary processes.
3. If a PhD student receives a job offer from any company, they will be considered unavailable for further placement opportunities.
