THE MISSION LIFE CELL AT IIT GOA

In October 2022 Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji and United Nations Secretary-General Mr António Guterres launched Mission LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment) at the Statue of Unity, Kevadia, Gujarat. It is a global plan of action that aims to save the planet from the disastrous consequences of climate change. Located in a fragile eco-sensitive area like Goa, with the vision to "strive to become a unique institution of higher learning, offering state of the art education, research, and training in science and technology to have impact on society, environment and global challenges", the Indian Institute of Technology Goa has established a The Mission LiFE Cell (MLC) to foster interdisciplinary studies, capacity building, training, research, and outreach in line with the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister. The inter-disciplinary Mission LiFE Cell draws upon the faculty and research teams of different schools and research centres of IIT Goa. It partners with experts and stakeholders from Governments, industry, public life and institutions.

Within a short period of time of its existence, MLC has undertaken several activities which include organizing the national Sustainability Summit and Awards for CPSEs, advocacy with the Ministries of Coal and Finance (DPE) in the Government of India leading to advisory by the Ministries to top CPSEs to associate with the activities of MLC at IIT Goa. The upcoming workshop partly funded by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India is another milestone reached in the activities of MLC.

Various environmental regulations and reporting frameworks, guidelines, and standards in the area of sustainability have been put in place by the Government of India and State Governments.
