ONLINE SPOT ADMISSIONS TO THE M. TECH PROGRAM

Spot Admission and Eligibility Requirements:

- Only the candidates that satisfy **both criteria A and B below** are ELIGIBLE for 'the Spot Admission' at IIT Goa.
A: Candidates who have applied for M.Tech. Program at IIT Goa (i.e. candidate having IIT Goa application No.) **AND**
B: Candidates who have **NOT TAKEN** admission in any other participating Institutes or NOT MARKED the "Accept & Freeze" option on the COAP.
- Candidates who have **rejected** IIT Goa's offer in COAP rounds are **NOT ELIGIBLE** for the 'Spot Admission' at IIT Goa.
- Additionally, for the **M.Tech in CSE** program, the following category-wise GATE-score cutoff needs to be met for eligibility in spot round:
 - UR: GATE score should be **greater than or equal to** 565 for Gender Neutral and 490 for Female seats.
 - EWS: GATE score should be **greater than or equal to** 490.
 - OBC: GATE score should be **greater than or equal to** 480.
 - SC: GATE score should be **greater than or equal to** 380.
- For **M.Tech. in Electrical Engineering (EE)** program:
 - For the Power and Control specialization, only GATE score in EE would be considered.
 - For the VLSI and Signal Processing specialization, only GATE score in EC would be considered.
- Candidates who have **CONFIRMED** admission to another academic unit of IIT Goa are **Not Eligible** for the 'Spot Admission' at IIT Goa (i.e. change of program/branch is NOT allowed).
- All interested applicants who are ELIGIBLE as per the criteria above will need to **REGISTER** for an **ONLINE SPOT ADMISSION ROUND to be conducted on 18 July 2025**. The registration form and details will be shared with the eligible applicants via registered email.
- Details of the Spot admission round will be shared to the registered candidate's email-ID.

Applicants who wish to participate should join the spot admission round 10 minutes before the start of the round in online mode and remain in the meeting until it concludes.

8. For students of the OBC-NCL category, certificates of OBC-NCL should be obtained on or after 1 April, 2025 and for students of the EWS category, certificates of EWS should be obtained for the financial year 2025-26.
9. Applicants who are offered a seat in the Spot round will be required to **confirm immediately and pay the seat confirmation fees** as applicable to their category (**Rs. 31,542/-** for General/OBC/EWS and **Rs. 26,542/-** for SC/ST/PwD category) on the spot **through an online payment gateway**. The fee details are available at link: [M.Tech fee structure](#). Failing to pay the fees will result in the seat being offered to the next candidate in the merit list.
10. When a seat is offered to a candidate during the spot round, temporary absence in the online meeting or a failure to pay the confirmation fees immediately will result in the seat being offered to the next candidate in the merit list. This process is final and irreversible; once a seat is forfeited, the candidate will not be reconsidered again.
11. Please note the fee paid for seat confirmation in the online spot admission round is **not refundable** under any circumstances.
