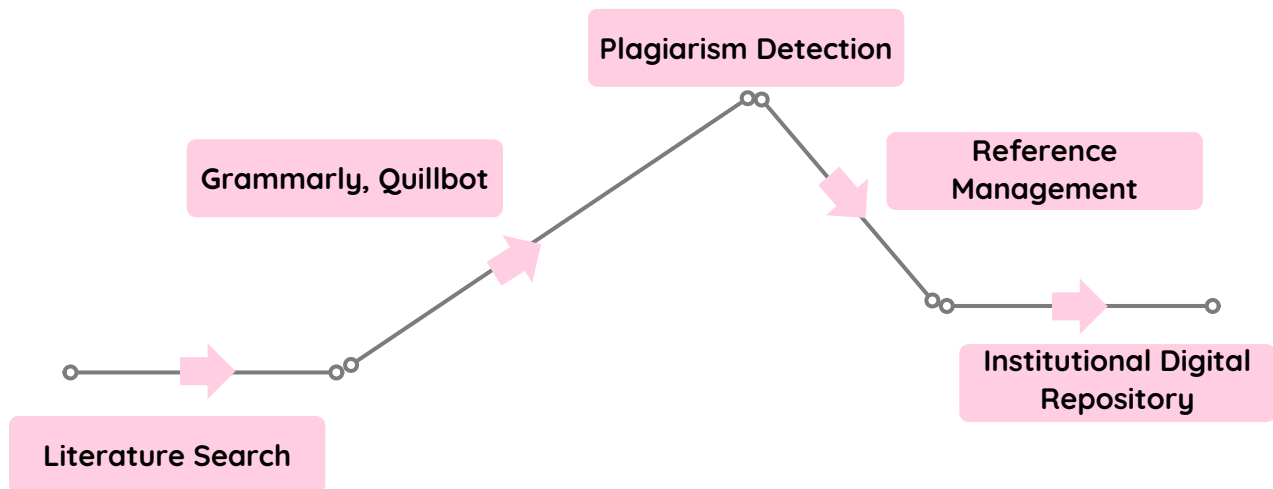

LIBRARY & INFORMATION SERVICES

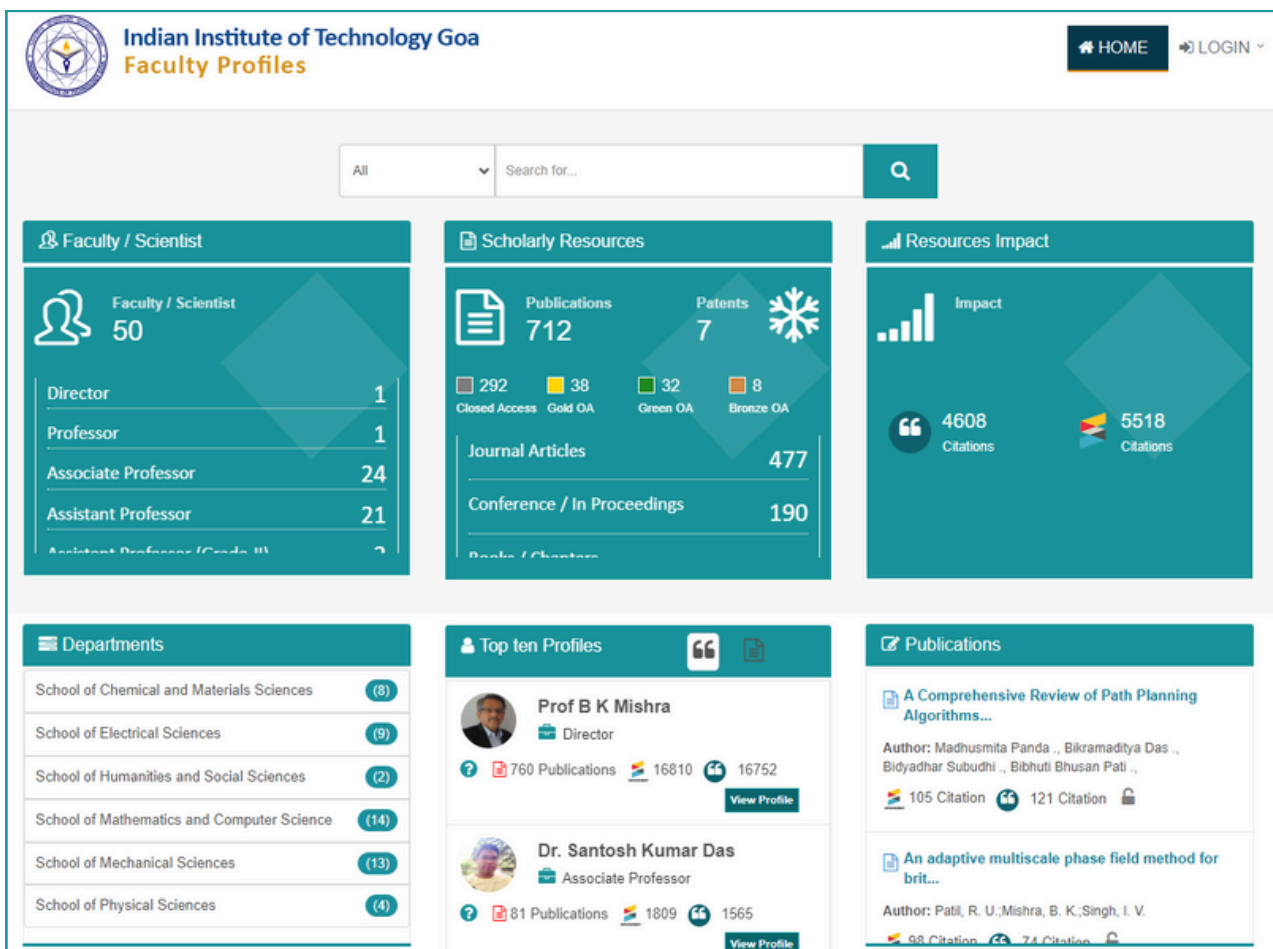
Circulation of Books	The total number of books transacted to our users during this year is 5413 compared to 4573 last year.
Print Magazines	The library circulates loose issues of print magazines among users.
Information/Reference Services	The library has been actively promoting reference & information services (in person & virtually) to its user community.
Document Delivery Service	To support the learning and research activities, the library received 156 requests and delivered 154 documents to the requested users.
Inter-Library Loan (ILL)	The library has also facilitated ILL requests through DELNET Membership and other academic libraries.
Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC)	Central Library offers computerized catalogue search service through the Web OPAC. Users can search library collection through this interface.

DIGITAL REPOSITORY

Institutional Digital Repository (<https://repository-library.iitgoa.ac.in/>) created using an open-source DSpace software has been kept up-to-date by adding the metadata with full-text of the PhD Dissertations, Master's Theses and abstracts of most of the scholarly publications generated by the Institute community. Efforts are being made to add full text of research papers wherever permitted.

LIBRARY EVENTS

The **LibQuiz** event was held on 14th August 2023, celebrating National Librarians Day, commemorating the 131st birth anniversary of Padmashree Dr. S.R. Ranganathan, Father of Library Science in India. Attendees, including students and staff, participated enthusiastically in the quiz, showcasing their passion for books and information.

The **Library Orientation Program** was held on 18th August 2023 at Mining Block. The program was meticulously planned to introduce the incoming BTech students to the library's facilities, collection, services, borrowing procedures, and the vast array of academic resources available in print and digital formats.

Central Library celebrated the **International Open Access Week** from 23-29 October 2023. Open Access Week is a global event highlighting the importance of open access to research and digital scholarship. Several open-access resources, such as OA search engines, OA repositories, and OA Journals, were promoted throughout the week to educate researchers, students, and faculty members about the open-access concept.

Online Scientific Writing Workshop was organized in collaboration with the American Chemical Society (ACS) to celebrate National Library Week on 17th November 2023. The workshop helped the research scholars and faculty members provide valuable insights to enhance their scientific writing skills and refine their abilities to communicate their research effectively.

User Awareness Webinar on SciSpace was organized on 28th November 2023 in collaboration with SciSpace. Various value-added features developed by SciSpace to assist and streamline the research process were highlighted, helping researchers understand and analyze scientific literature more easily.

User Awareness Webinar on QuillBot was organized on 18th January 2024. The session gave attendees a comprehensive understanding of QuillBot, a cutting-edge AI-powered writing assistant. QuillBot's features, functionalities, and its potential to revolutionize the writing process were presented through live demonstrations.

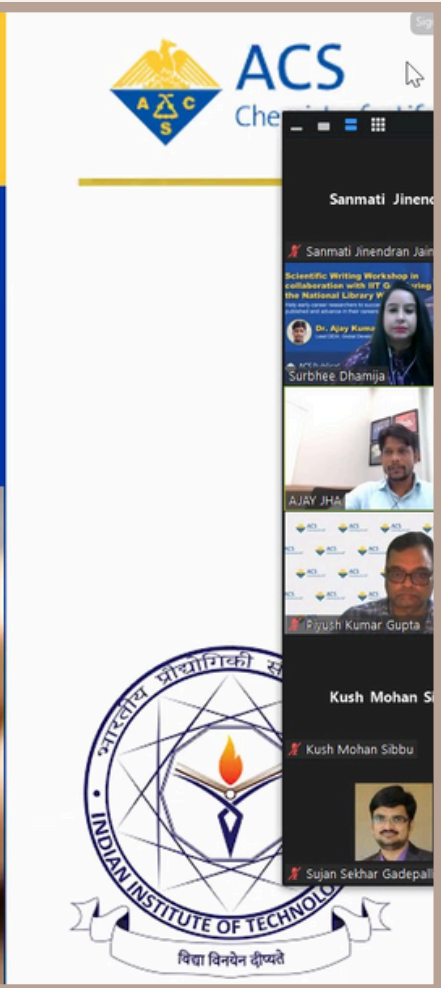
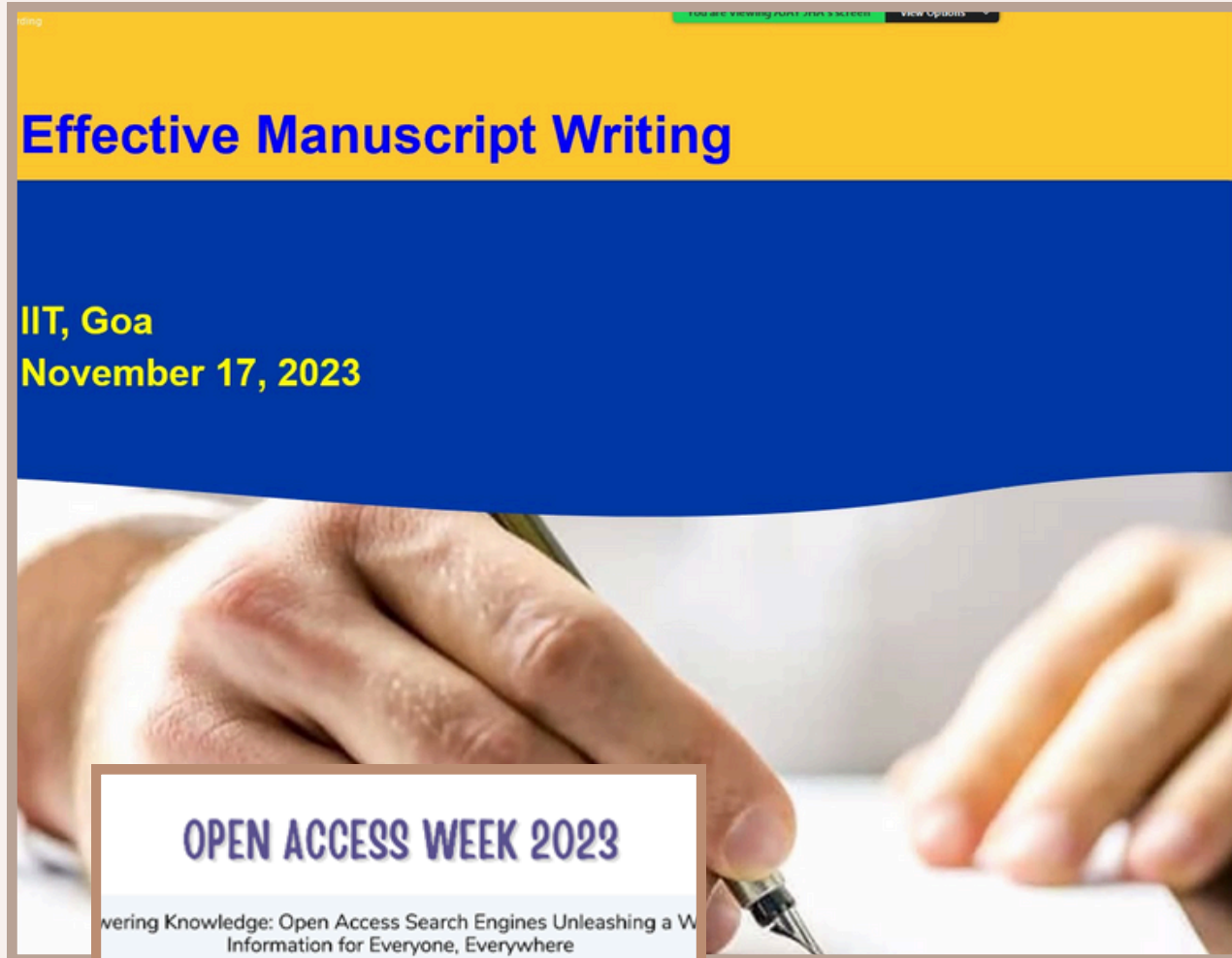
