Yet, nothing captures the collective excitement and energy quite like CultRang — the institute's annual techno-cultural fest. Deeply rooted in student ethos and shared memories, this year's CultRang stood out as a vibrant celebration, paying homage to the dynamic spirit of the IIT Goa community

Hosted from **31-01-2025** to **02-02-2025**, CultRang'25 embraced the theme 'A Cascade Of Contrasts', celebrating the beauty of dualities and their intricate interplay. With over 40 events - including competitions and resourceful workshops by experts and professionals - this year's edition proved to be an enthralling experience for all involved.



The technical events covered core aspects of engineering such as coding, web development, data and digital security, electronics, robotics, motorsports and technical design. The events not only showcased the technical skills of the participants but also encouraged innovation, collaboration and real-world problem solving while promoting healthy competition. IIT GOA VISITS NCPOR

On **04-12-24**, a five-member delegation from IIT Goa, led by **Prof Dhirendra S. Katti** (Director, IIT Goa) visited the National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research (NCPOR), Goa, for a research collaboration meeting. The NCPOR team, headed by **Dr Thamban Meloth** (Director, NCPOR), delivered presentations on 'Polar Science Initiatives' and the 'Deep Sea Exploration Initiative.' The discussions focused on identifying collaborative research opportunities between IIT Goa and NCPOR in key areas such as Polar Sciences, Deep Ocean studies, and Himalayan Glaciology. The visit concluded with a guided tour of NCPOR's Central Laboratories.



IIT GOA AT IINVENTIVE

IIT Goa participated in the third edition of **IInvenTiv 2025**, a national research and innovation expo hosted by the Indian Institute of Technology Madras on **28-02-2025** and **01-03 2025**. The event, jointly organized with the Ministry of Education, Government of India, brought together premier Indian technical institutes to showcase their cutting-edge research and technological advancements.



As part of the exhibition, IIT Goa presented two research projects: a drone-based helmet detection system, supervised by **Dr Shitala Prasad**, **Dr Clint P. George**, and **Dr Sharad Sinha**, aimed at enhancing road safety through automated surveillance and a project on the mechanical modeling of cells, led by **Dr Sreenath Balakrishnan**, focusing on understanding biomechanical behaviors at the cellular level. These projects reflect IIT Goa's commitment to deliver impactful interdisciplinary research in alignment with national innovation goals.

VISITORS' CONFERENCE 2024-2025

Prof Dhirendra S. Katti (Director, IIT Goa) attended the two-day Visitors' Conference 2024-25 held at Rashtrapati Bhavan from 03-03-25 to 04-03-25. The Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, and the Hon'ble Minister of Education, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan attended the event and addressed key stakeholders in higher education across India.



The conference centered on critical themes aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP), including academic flexibility, internationalization, translational research, and reforms in student selection and assessment. The gathering provided a valuable platform for academic leaders to deliberate on strategies that can strengthen India's higher education ecosystem.



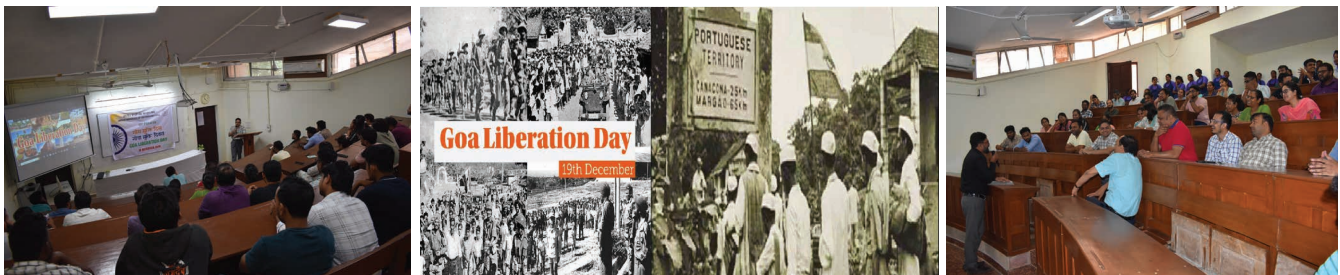
BHARATIYA BHASHA UTSAV

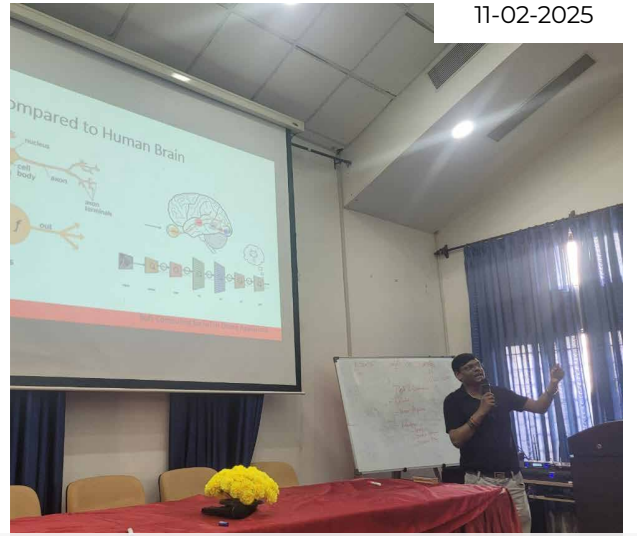

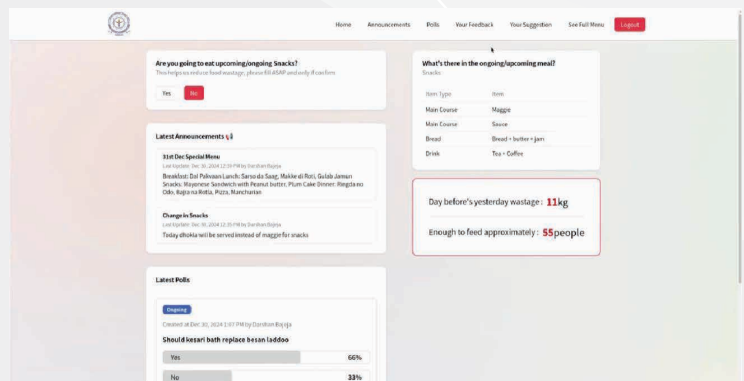
EVENTS

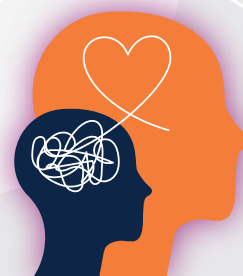


A VALENTINE FOR YOURSELF

INTER DEPARTMENT MINI SPORTS TOURNAMENT '25

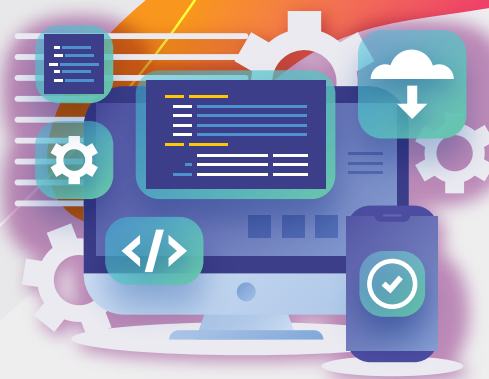

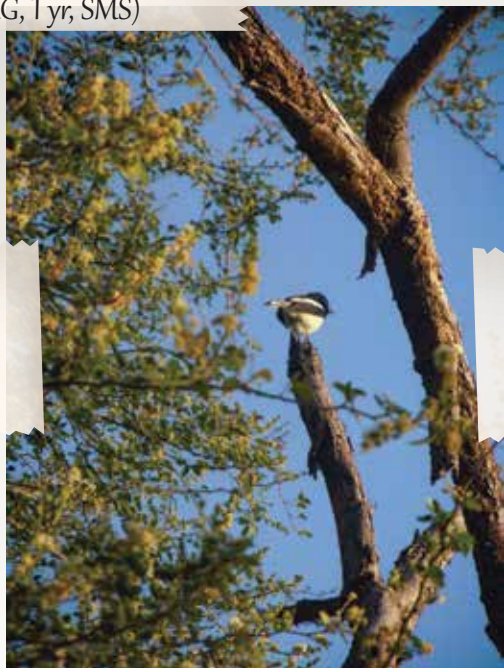

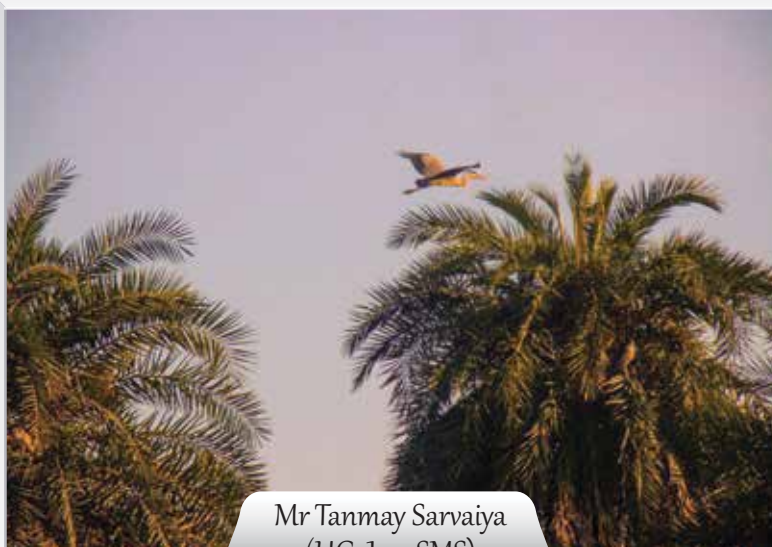

Another post shared said:

"The IIT dream is over. I have no college, no friends, no future, and no one to talk to."

This child, at just 18 years old, felt a void in his life because he couldn't crack an exam. According to him, he couldn't make his parents proud.

To that child:

Trust me—I've been there.

I've felt that chaos weighing down on me when I failed to meet the expectations that so-called society placed on me.

But it gets better. Always.

Life becomes beautiful. Always.

My parents? They're more than proud. I see a twinkle in my mum's eyes every time I come home for the holidays. Not because of my marks. But because I come home—not broken, not lost.

This whole facade of education is so absurd. How can we expect a 15-year-old to tie their entire worth to one exam? And when they don't make it, their confidence shatters—not just cracks, but splinters into pieces too scattered to gather again.

Those little shoulders deserve love, support, and a pat on their back—in failure and in success.

Yet I've heard parents say to their children:
"You're our last hope. This exam is your last chance."
Imagine the pressure that child faces upon hearing those words.
The weight is enormous. Crushing.
It's like a storm cloud that never clears.

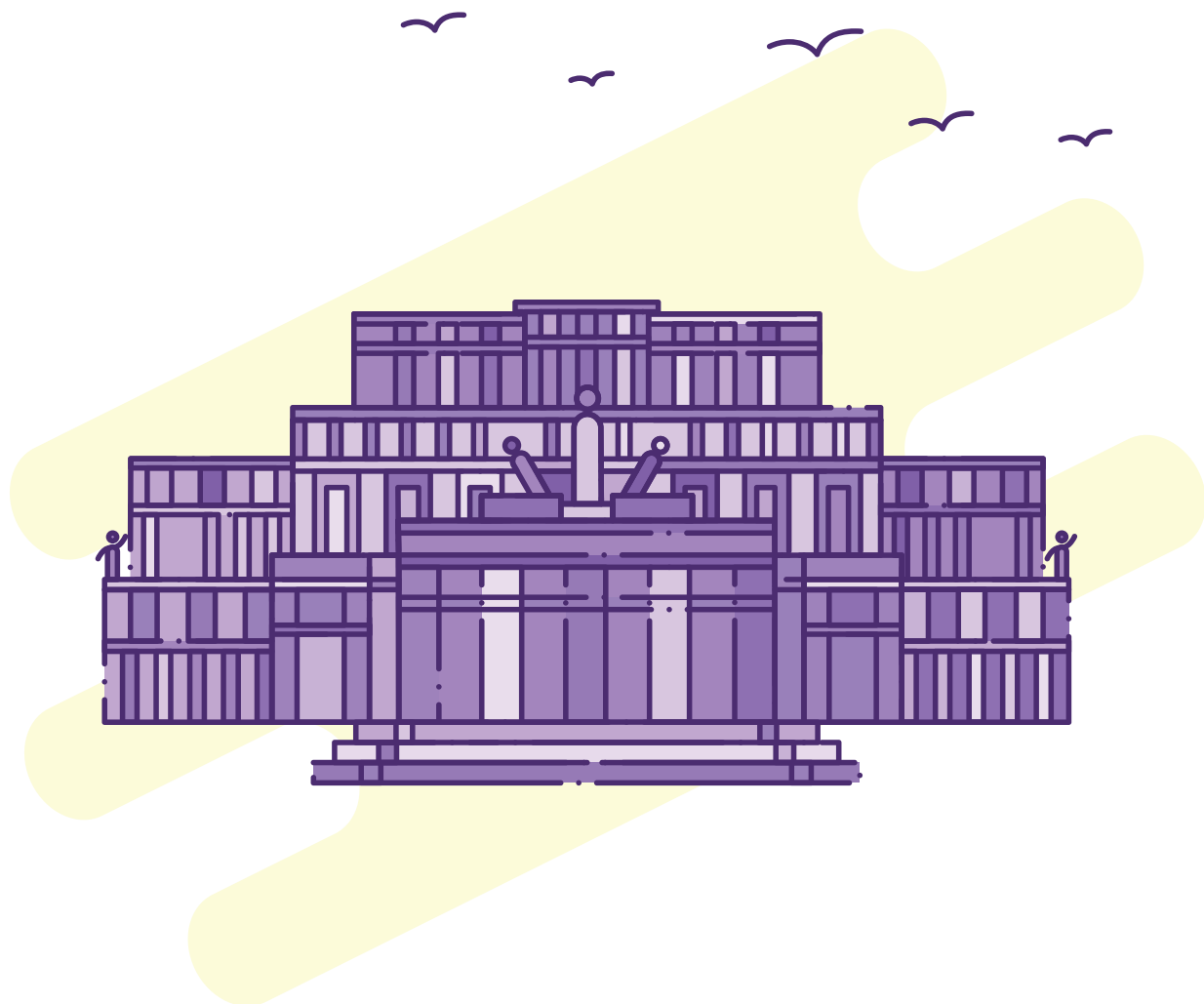
